
It is hard to believe that the Thanksgiving holiday is just a few weeks away.



HOW TO PICK GOOD FIT BOOKS

Many parents ask "How can I help my child choose books that he or she can read?" Here are some easy steps that you and your child can follow in order to choose good fit books using the acronym IPICK:

- 1. Have your child choose a book. This is the first I in IPICK which means "I choose a book to read."
- 2. Ask your child "What is your purpose for choosing this book?". You may also want to ask, "Is it for fun or to learn something?". This is the P which means purpose.
- 3. Ask your child,"Is this a book you are interested in?" .This is the second I, which means interest.
- 4. Have your child read a page of the book. After your child reads the page, ask your child, "Who or what did you just read about?". This is the C in IPICK which stands for comprehend. If it is a good fit book your child should be able to tell you about what they just read.
- 5. Have your child read another page (or use the same page) and ask, "Did you know the words?". This is the K in IPICK which stands for know the words. Your child should know all or almost all of the words in order for it to be a good fit book.


